Notice to Shareholders of the Fund Danske Invest Allocation – Equity Opportunities

Dear Shareholders,

We are writing to inform you of the imminent termination of **Danske Invest Allocation** – **Equity Opportunities** (the "Fund"), a fund of the Danske Invest Allocation (the "SICAV").

According to Article 24 of the SICAV 's articles of incorporation, in the event that for any reason the value of the total net assets in any fund of the SICAV has decreased to, or has not reached, an amount determined by the SICAV's board of directors (the "Board") to be the minimum level of net assets for such fund allowing it to be operated in an economically efficient manner or, in case of a substantial modification in the political, economic or monetary situation or, as a matter of economic rationalization or, if the interests of the shareholders would justify it, the Board may decide to redeem all the shares of the relevant fund at the net asset value per share (taking into account actual realization prices of investments and realization expenses) calculated on the Valuation Day at which such decision shall take effect.

1. Reason for the liquidation

The net asset value as at 7 January 2019 was the following: EUR 4,557,572.09 whilst the total net assets of the Fund amounted to EUR 6,239,380.52 at the end of June 2018. The Board is anticipating that the demand for shares of the Fund is low and the increase of demand to be very unlikely.

Having taken into account all relevant factors, namely that the assets of the Fund will reach a level which no longer allows for the Fund to be operated in an economically efficient manner and, due to the relatively low trading volume of the Fund, the Board is of the view that the contemplated termination of the Fund would be in the best interest of the shareholders of the Fund.

As a result of the above, the Board has decided to close the Fund for subscription (including switches in) by any additional investor as of 21 January 2019, terminate the Fund and start liquidating its portfolio (the "Liquidation") with effect as of 18 February 2019 (the "Liquidation Date")

The Board will process the Liquidation in accordance with applicable Luxembourg laws and regulations.

2. Terms

The costs associated with this Liquidation will be borne by the Management Company.

Subscriptions (including switches in) of the shares in the Fund will not be possible after 21 January 2019, and redemptions or switches out of shares in the Fund will not be possible after 17:30 CET 13 February 2019. From 21 January 2019 to 18 February 2019, the calculation of Net Asset Value will continue to be performed on a daily basis as the Fund will still be invested according to the Investment Objective and Policy described in the prospectus.

The liquidation proceeds to be paid to the Fund's shareholders will be determined and paid out as soon as possible after the closure of the Liquidation. After such closure of the Liquidation, any liquidation proceeds not distributed to the Fund's shareholders will be deposited with the *Caisse de Consignation* in Luxembourg.

We recommend you to seek advice from your usual tax advisor on the implications of the termination of the Fund.
